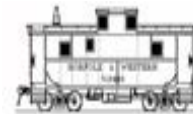

2024 was a good year for the Grande Nurses Training Program. There were six nurses scholarships awarded totaling \$5,000 and seven students graduated as Registered Nurses. An additional \$75.50 was donated to the Boland Trust Fund.

The individual Voitures spent 306 man-hours equaling \$1,530, and drove 1765 miles equaling \$882.50, in support of the program.

A total of \$7,890 was spent by the Voitures of Grande du Virginia on Nurses Training and I congratulate them on a job well done. I hope this excellent participation continues into 2025.

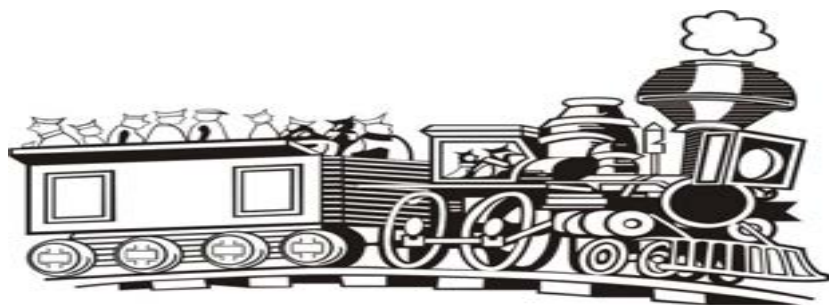
